The purpose of this information document is to provide general information relating to the Automated Dispatch and Messaging System.

2 Ancillary Services that are Dispatched through the Automated Dispatch and Messaging System

As referenced in the applicability section of Section 201.10, the AESO dispatches or directs the following ancillary services through the Automated Dispatch and Messaging System:

- (a) spinning reserve;
- (b) supplemental reserve;
- (c) regulating reserve; and
- (d) transmission must run.
