The AESO is seeking comments from Stakeholders with regard to the following matters:

	Questions	Stakeholder Comments
1.	Are there areas where further clarity on expected participation would be helpful?	The qualification into various markets appears to be based off of a power value without any discussion of duration. Further clarity may be required on how duration may impact qualification requirements.
2.	Are there areas of market participation that in your view need special consideration for energy storage that are not identified in the overview document?	As the AESO is aware, the topic of self-supply and export is currently being debated in industry. That is – should the energy being produced by a generating unit be solely for self-supply or export or are there situations (outside of the existing exemptions) where both could apply. Ultimately, matters relating to self-supply and export will require a clear policy direction from the Government, which may impact the rules for energy storage resources. We look forward to further consultation and discussion with the department staff on this issue.
3.	Additional comments	ENMAX looks forward to continued discussion and consultation with the AESO regarding energy storage, as there are many types and capabilities within the storage category. While the overview document does not apply to gas hybrids, it would be ENMAX's expectation that gas hybrids would be able to use their charge capability in the operating reserves market.
