1.	Are there areas where further clarity on expected participation would be helpful?	- If there are significant changes to energy storage participation from the short term phase to the long term implementation, will initial projects be grandfathered on certain aspects within the Authoritative Document or vice versa (if the long-term rules make more sense or are more inclusive etc.)?
		- Would like more information on the proposed concepts of the changes to the Tariff change for battery storage (section 7.1 Rate DTS).
