Implement option A, in future, but <i>delay</i> due to conflicting priorities and external issues that exist today C. <i>Maintain current pricing framework</i>– AESO will continue to monitor the state of the market for signs of loss of system efficiencies <p>Do you believe there other alternatives that should have been considered. If yes, please elaborate.</p>	<p>Lionstooth supports Option 3, maintaining the current pricing framework.</p>
