To: The Market Surveillance Administrator, Market Participants and Other Interested Parties (“Stakeholders”)

Re: **Letter of Notice for Administrative Amendments to Section 304.3 of the ISO rules, *Wind and Solar Power Ramp Up Management* (“Section 304.3”)**

Pursuant to Section 10 of Alberta Utilities Commission Rule 017: *Procedures and Process for Development of ISO Rules and Filing of ISO Rules with the Alberta Utilities Commission* (“AUC Rule 017”), the Alberta Electric System Operator (“AESO”) is providing notice and seeking feedback from Stakeholders on administrative amendments to Section 304.3.

### Issue

In support of the Government of Alberta’s *Red Tape Reduction Initiative*, the AESO is committed to reducing regulatory requirements by one-third by 2023. To achieve this, the AESO is reviewing its authoritative documents and exploring opportunities to reduce its regulatory requirements.

The AESO has reviewed Section 304.3 and determined that there is an opportunity to streamline several repetitive provisions and perform other administrative updates. The proposed amended Section 304.3 would result in a reduction of 6 regulatory requirements, as defined by the Government of Alberta.

### Purpose

The AESO is proposing administrative amendments that remove and consolidate certain provisions in order to improve clarity, reduce repetition, and reduce overall requirements in alignment with the Government of Alberta’s Red Tape Reduction initiative. In addition, the AESO is proposing other administrative amendments that will correct typographical errors, update current drafting style to align with the AESO’s drafting principles, and clarify the language of the ISO rule without changing its effect.

### Proposed Consultation and Timeline

The AESO is of the opinion that the scope of the issues identified is relatively minimal. Therefore, the AESO is targeting completion of Stakeholder consultation for the proposed amended Section 304.3 by March 2021. The AESO proposes Stakeholder consultation for the administrative amendment on the proposed amended Section 304.3 by way of a written process as follows:

- 1) February 11, 2021 – the AESO has posted a blacklined and clean copy of the proposed amended Section 304.3 for written comment;
- 2) February 2021 – the AESO will provide 2 weeks for Stakeholders to submit written comments on the draft of the proposed amended Section 304.3 with comments due February 26, 2021;
- 3) March 2021 – the AESO will post all written comments from Stakeholders and provide the AESO’s written responses to Stakeholder comments; and
- 4) March/April 2021– provided there are no outstanding Stakeholder concerns, the AESO will submit an application to the Alberta Utilities Commission (“Commission”) for approval of the proposed amended Section 304.3

## Stakeholder Comments

Stakeholders may submit written comments to the AESO using the *Stakeholder Comment Matrix – Administrative Amendments to an ISO Rule*. Stakeholders should ensure that comments provided represent all interests within their organization.

The deadline for Stakeholders to provide comments to [rules\\_comments@aeso.ca](mailto:rules_comments@aeso.ca) is **February 26, 2021**. Adherence to deadlines is essential to the integrity of the comment process, and as such, the AESO may choose not to consider any Stakeholder comments received after the deadline.

The AESO will post all comments it receives on the AESO's website. The AESO will provide written responses to the comments received and post those responses on the AESO's website. The AESO is posting this notice pursuant to the requirements in AUC Rule 017 and is proposing no further consultation. If the AESO does not receive any comments regarding the proposed amended Section 304.3, the AESO will proceed directly to filing an application with the Commission for approval.
