Rider C Voltage Control Charge for the 3rd Quarter of 2021 Re:

Please note that the Rider C rate for the Voltage control charge rate component which was posted on May 31, 2021 shows a 340.32% charge for the third quarter of 2021. The 340.32% charge is derived by taking the Monthly Variance Total Shortfall for 2021 divided by the Remaining Revenue to be collected from July to December.

The increase in the Voltage control charge rate component for the third quarter is due to the AESO's incurred costs of unforeseeable Transmission Must-Run in 2021. The AESO must recover these costs through Rider C in accordance with section 2(4) of Rider C in the ISO Tariff. The total estimated costs have increased from \$0.4M in the second quarter to \$1.5M in the third quarter of 2021, contributing to a 370% increase in the Voltage control charge rate component of Rider C. Currently, the Voltage Control Charge is \$0.01/MWh per section 6 of the Rate DTS in the ISO Tariff. Therefore, the 370% increase in the Voltage control charge rate component raises the Voltage Control Charge to \$0.037/MWh.
